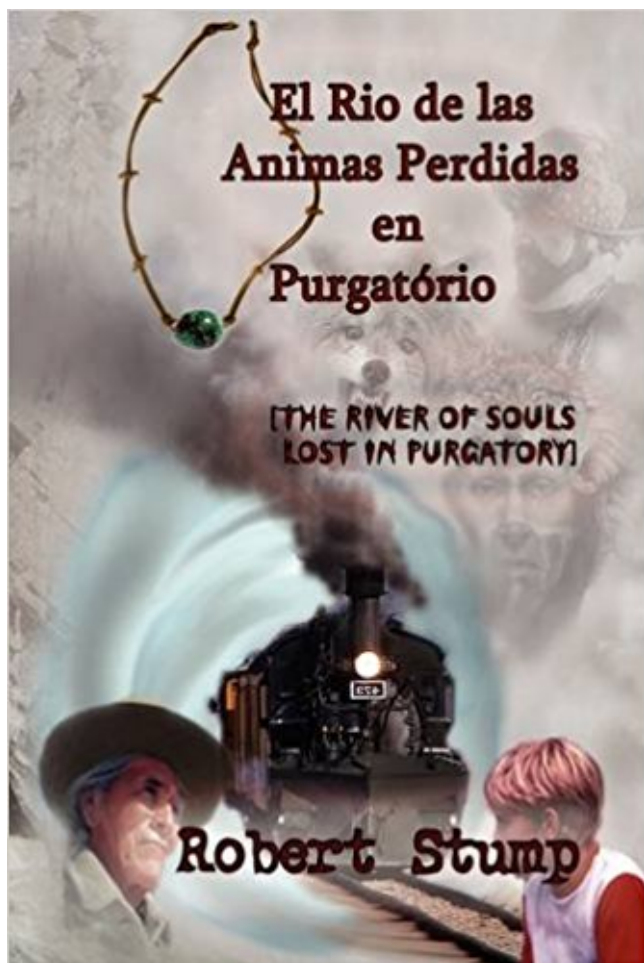

26 Apr 2013 . Rivera and his troops dubbed the river's rushing waters and surrounding Animas Valley "El Rio de las Animas Perdidas en Purgatorio," or "the River of the Lost Souls in Purgatory" because they viewed the remote region as bleak and void of the treasures they sought. Over the years Rivera and his men.

8 Sep 2017 . The river was dubbed "El Río de las Ánimas Perdidas en Purgatorio," which translates roughly to River of Lost Souls in Purgatory. The second popular legend about the Animas' name has it that Spanish explorers spotted all the empty homes left behind when Ancestral Puebloans mysteriously left the area.

These early Spanish explorers left their own memorial in the beautiful names they bestowed upon mountains, rivers, and places throughout southern Colorado, among others the Rio Grande del Norte, the Sangre de Cristo and San Juan mountains, and El Rio de Las Animas Perdidas en Purgatorio, or "River of Souls Lost.

10 Aug 2006 . Picket Wire gets its name from the Purgatoire River, which Spaniards dubbed El Rio de Las Animas Perdidas en Purgatorio, or The River of Lost Souls in Purgatory, following an Indian slaughter of Spanish explorers who never received last rites from a priest.

When French-speaking fur trappers came.

The small community lies at the confluence of El Rio de las Animas Perdidas en Purgatorio and Raton Creek and has long been a favorite camping site from nomadic Native American tribes and French trappers to today's visitors.
